



Our Lady's Catholic Primary: Physical Education

Coverage and Expectations

We use The PE hub as a foundation for our PE delivery. We dedicate timetabled time each week to PE lessons. The long-term plan is available to download from the PE curriculum planning folder on OneDrive and SharePoint.

Planning Expectations and Links

The long-term planning document is saved and shared centrally via SharePoint. Lesson planning from The PE Hub will need to be reviewed and adjusted to ensure it meets the needs of your class. It is important for teachers to also be aware of the importance of safety and to plan it in their lessons.

Planning, key information and resources can be found on The PE Hub and in the PE Cupboard located off the main hall. All Staff have access to the planning via the PE Hub login, details are shared in the PE folder on SharePoint.

Assessment and Feedback

Verbal feedback will be given to encourage pupils to reflect on and improve their work. Pupils should also be encouraged to self and peer assess one another.

Cross curricular links

Where possible, PE can be used across the curriculum to encourage engagement and apply learned skills and knowledge in a different context e.g. in Science and Personal Relationships Education to support understanding of how we care for bodies by keeping fit and healthy.

Catholic Social Teaching

Catholic Social Teaching will be referred to across the PE Curriculum.

Lesson Structure

Every PE lesson begins with retrieval either from a previous lesson, unit or year group and discussion of key vocabulary.

In each lesson, teacher modelling is key to ensure pupils are able to achieve the learning objective.

Pupils will work independently, in pairs, small groups and larger groups and teams in structured and unstructured ways.

Environment

PE lessons will be delivered in an environment where pupils feel safe and confident to develop their skills.

All tasks and activities that the children partake in need to be safe, with appropriate risk assessments made prior to learning.

There is no expectation for a PE display in classrooms, although you may like to add elements of PE lessons to other displays as appropriate.

Presentation of work

In PE lessons photographs and videos of pupils will be recorded and used along side pupil comments and reflections to support with documenting coverage and progress.

Vocabulary / Oracy and Language Development

During PE lessons children will be given the opportunity to discuss and share ideas with their peers and with the teacher. New vocabulary and language will be discussed and explained as part of the teaching.
