



## Our Lady's Catholic Primary: Personal Relationships Education

### Coverage and Expectations

We use Life to the Full as a foundation for our Personal Relationships Education delivery. We dedicate regular timetabled time each week to Personal Relationships Education lessons. The long-term plan is available to download from the Personal Relationships Education curriculum planning folder on OneDrive and SharePoint.

### Planning Expectations and Links

Long term planning documents are all saved and shared centrally via SharePoint. Planning will need to be reviewed and adjusted to ensure it meets the needs of your class.

Planning, key information and resources can be found on Life to the Full. Each teacher and HLTA will have their own login.

Pupils should have the opportunity to: discuss and reflect on how they are created and loved by God, created to love others and created to live as part of a community.

### Assessment and Feedback

For the most part, feedback will be given orally to encourage pupils to reflect on and improve their work. Pupils should also be encouraged to self and peer assess one another.

### Cross curricular links

Where possible, Personal Relationships Education can be used across the curriculum to encourage engagement and apply learned skills and knowledge in a different context e.g. in Science and RE to support understanding of how we care for ourselves and God's creation.

### Lesson Structure

Every Personal Relationships Education lesson begins with retrieval either from a previous lesson, unit or year group.

In each lesson, teacher modelling is key to ensure pupils are able to achieve the learning objective.

### Environment

There is no expectation for a Personal Relationships Education display in classrooms, although you may like to add elements of Personal Relationships Education lessons to other displays as appropriate.

We aim to create an environment where pupils feel confident to develop their creativity and express themselves.

### Presentation of work

Personal Relationships Education lessons will be recorded in a 'big book'. This should consist of photos, pupil work, comments and key vocabulary that has been learned.

### Vocabulary / Oracy and Language development

During Personal Relationships Education lessons children will be given the opportunity to discuss and share ideas with their peers and with the teacher. New vocabulary and language will be discussed and explained as part of the teaching.

### Catholic Social Teaching

Catholic Social Teaching will be referred to across the Personal Relationships Education Curriculum .
